NAPLAN results for students in Years Three and Five have been communicated to schools. It is early days (and there is a new site to navigate for schools!) but initial looks have been pleasing. About 20% of the state did the online version (we didn’t) so you may have heard in the media some commentators saying the results are therefore harder to compare this year as the online version directed students to different questions, depending on their answers to previous question. My opinion of NAPLAN has always been that it is a useful tool to look at trends which may assist us with future planning. Individual student results will be distributed in the coming week.

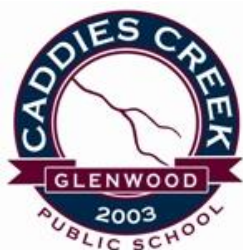
