State Knockout Cricket: Round Six vs. Condobolin

We travelled to Bathurst as a halfway point for our top 16 match against Condobolin. In cold, blustery conditions, Condobolin won the toss and elected to bat. While they blasted out some quick runs, the Caddies bowlers took some quick wickets and then bowled economically in trying conditions. Roop (3/20), Ishar (1/8) and Sam (0/13) helping restrict Condobolin to 6/114. In reply, Roop scored a quickfire 23, before falling for the first time this season, Gurjit finishing off what Roop started with an unbeaten 39*. Sajith batted through the innings with a chanceless 23*, Caddies Creek chasing down the total with 4 overs remaining.

Round Seven vs. Boronia Park

With the finals due to be played in week 8, we had a very short turnaround for our top 8 match against Boronia Park. Boronia Park won the toss and elected to bat. Boronia Park scored at an excellent rate, especially in the final five overs, but Caddies were able to take consistent wickets. Roop (2/23), Thomas (1/5) and Mehtaj (1/10) taking the wickets. Mehtaj also enacting two brilliant run outs. Boronia Park finishing 6/141, a considerable score in this format. Caddies started their innings well but Boronia Park were able to find a wicket every time Caddies started to build a partnership. Roop's unbeaten 41* was ably supported by Gurjit (15), Ishar (19) but the superb Boronia Park bowling and exceptional fielding slowed the Caddies innings. A late flourish from Thomas (12*) brought Caddies to 8/127, fourteen runs short of the required score.

Congratulations to our wonderful team for making the top 8 in a competition that started with over 270 teams across the State. They have played a wonderfully entertaining brand of cricket with enthusiasm, skill and determination. Congratulations boys! I would also like to once again thank all the parents who have driven the team to our numerous away games and supported us every step of the way. A final massive thank you to Mrs Henson and Mrs Glanville for lending us your larger vehicles, without you we would not have been able to participate in this competition.

P&C Successful Grant Application – In June this year the P&C, assisted by Mrs Kelly and Mr Beggs, submitted an application to the NSW Government as a part of their 2018 Community Building Partnerships Program for a grant to assist with the purchase, construction and installation of an all-weather structure for the school’s Quiet Area, between the kindergarten classrooms over the blue and red tables. We were thrilled to be contacted by Kevin Conolly MP, Member for Riverstone last week to inform us that the P&C had been successful in securing the grant and that we would be receiving **\$16,760** to cover the completion of the project in its entirety. We can’t wait for the cover to be finished and the new area to be in use all year round.
