- Before reading, talk with your child about the cover of the book; the title and the pictures and discuss what the story might be about.
 - While you are reading, pause and discuss what has been read up until that point. Attempt to predict what might happen next.
- After you've finished reading with your child, continue to talk about the story. Ask questions about it and any pictures.
- When you're reading together, try to make the time relaxed, enjoyable and positive. Vary it. You can take turns reading, read together, read to your child or have them read to you.
