

The Blacktown Workers Club have asked us to let you know they are having a membership drive at the moment, and if you wish to join it is only \$6.



#### **P&C Successful Grant Application**

As mentioned in last week's Chronicle in June this year the P&C, assisted by Mrs Kelly and Mr Beggs, submitted an application to the NSW Government as a part of their 2018 Community Building Partnerships Program for a grant to assist with the purchase, construction and installation of an all-weather structure for the schools Quiet Area, between the kindergarten classrooms over the blue and red tables. We were thrilled to be contacted by Kevin Conolly MP, Member for Riverstone in early November to inform us that the P&C had been successful in securing the grant and that we would be receiving \$16,760 to cover the completion of the project in its entirety.

You may have noticed that the Quiet Area All Weather Cover is <u>already</u> up with teachers and students using the space. We hope you agree that it looks amazing!

There were many months of planning and organising by Mrs Kelly, with the P&C having already committed to paying for the cover..... it just so happened that the grant approval came through a week before it was scheduled to be constructed, so the grant money will be used to pay for the cover and the money the P&C had earmarked for this project will be redirected to something else on the School Executives 'wish list'.
