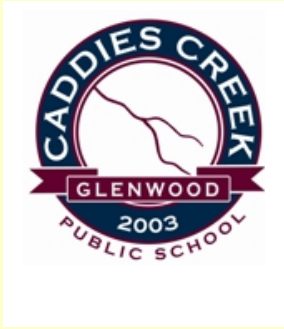

Cash is accepted. An EFTPOS option will be available enabling parents/carers to purchase tickets with credit/debit cards. (Please note as standard with these facilities a merchant fee will be incurred).
