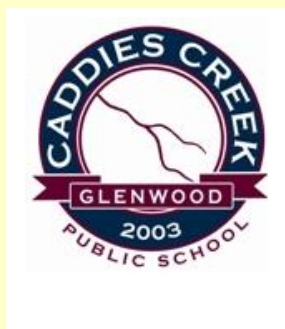

But firstly, we would like to thank all the wonderful teachers and parent volunteers who gave up their time at this time of year to help supervise the disco. **THANK YOU.** Then to all our wonderful Caddies students who attended the disco **THANK YOU.** We hope you have had a wonderful night. We were able to raise \$2,309.92 as a result of the disco, funds which we are sure can be put to good use in supporting the school next year.

P&C AGM & Meeting – We would sincerely like to thank everyone who has attended meetings in 2019 and we look forward to seeing you again, along with some new faces in 2020. Our first meeting will be Tuesday 25th February 2020.

We were so pleased to table the P&C fundraising report and end of year financials culminating in an **AMAZING** and **RECORD-BREAKING** fundraising profit of just over **\$53,311.43!** An incredible result thanks to the generous school community support here at Caddies. Thank you, we look forward to using these funds to purchase items to support the wonderful CCPS students and teachers.

In 2019 the P&C contributed almost **\$80,000** to State and National representatives, the choral and primary proms choir groups, additional collaborative learning tables for years 1 and 2, the aqua fill water bubblers, house coloured supporter kits for use at swimming & athletics carnivals, purchase of new smartboards, kindy headphones for reading groups, an annual Scholastic book subscription of 200 new books for the library, new school blazers and a sizable contribution of \$50,000 towards the new collaborative learning area near Kindergarten that will be underway very soon.
