School Details

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School App Skoolbag Today is easily my worst job of the year – telling all those fabulous Year Five students who were, and who weren't, elected school leaders for 2021. Usually there are a couple of tears here and there but usually the kids are pretty good about it. It's very hard when you have 139 students in the grade and only 6 are elected. There will be plenty of other leadership opportunities next year for many students, and this year's Year Five are such a great group that I can't wait until next year when they show off their skills in different areas.

As you can imagine there has been much talk amongst schools regarding their end of year presentation assemblies. Principals, up until less than a week ago, were still seeking clarification. The guidelines do state that if we had a mix of parents and students at a presentation assembly, the 4 square metre rule would apply to everyone, including students. This is the same with the Year 6 Farewell. This means 76 people maximum at a time in our hall. Since our smallest cohort is 130 students, there was sadly no way we could have parents attend (unless we had 20+ assemblies!). I probably can't say I am as disappointed as those parents, but I'm close! There is nothing better than seeing the delight on parents' and students' faces as they receive their award. Letters went home last week to parents whose children are to receive awards.

Next week's Presentation Assemblies (there will be seven – one for each grade) look like this:

Wednesday 2nd December – Year 5, Year 6, Year 3 and Year 4 (We are having Year Five first so we can announce the School Leaders)
Thursday 3rd December – Year 1, Kindergarten, Year 2

We will be recording the assemblies and putting them on Google Classroom/Class Dojo, so hopefully when your child comes home you will be able to watch it together (multiple times if you wish!).

This week Year Five and Year Three students completed the School Readiness Test, which was a mock single online test to see how doing NAPLAN online at Caddies Creek in 2021 would go, student wise and system wise. It went quite smoothly, which bodes well for next year. It still will be a challenge with a school of our size – if we have five Year Three and five Year Five classes next year for example, and each student does the regular NAPLAN of four tests, that makes forty tests over a two week period to be completed.

Today was also the last day of Kindergarten Orientation, and as I said before, even though it was a different format this year, all seemed to go really well. I would like to thank Mrs Nammour, the class teachers and all our other support staff who made things run so smoothly. We are looking at five Kindergarten classes for next year at this stage, so to all those Kinder 2021 parents, please don't assume the groups they were in for the last two weeks are "the group" they will be in (maybe reinforce that to them over the Christmas break).


