Dear Parents,

It is wonderful to see our students becoming aware of the need to reuse and recycle. We have a number of specialised bins throughout the school each holding a different type of rubbish. Each bin has a poster attached which shows the type of rubbish that goes in each bin. It does take a while for this knowledge to sink in and the bin process to become automatic. Our Eco crusaders do a fabulous job keeping an eye on the rubbish collections, sorting and often taking our rubbish to external collection stations. Mrs Henson and Mrs Van De Maele, along with other team members, often get the job of resorting bins when the wrong type of rubbish has been placed inside. Certainly not the most pleasant job but their dedication and enthusiasm must be commended and admired. A number of parents have told me that their children are now keeping the family true to recycling as well which is fantastic to hear. I received a lovely letter on Monday from a Year 5 student, Manya, who has led a return and earn campaign at home raising \$15. Thank you to the Years 3 and 5 teachers for administering each session and Mrs Buyruk and Mr Lehner for the initial set up, timetabling, support to students and staff and conducting catch up sessions for those students who may have been absent. Tomorrow will be the last catch up day. Teachers and students can now return to their usual classroom routines.

We have had a drop in morning temperatures this week so it is probably a timely reminder to make sure all uniform items are suitably labelled. We have had some items that have been passed onto other students which is great but please remember to change the name on the label to the current owner. It has been very difficult to return these items as we have no way of knowing who the new owner is now. 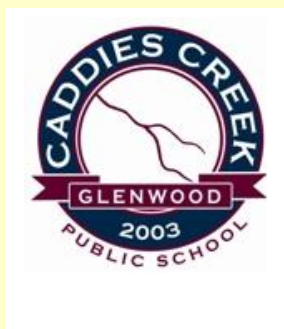

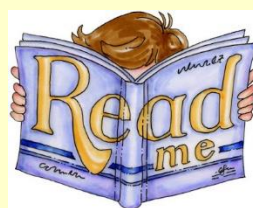
