News from the Principal

Dear Parents and Carers,

The Department of Education has launched an exciting new digital communication tool, the NSW Education Parent App to help support good school-home communication. The app already has 180,000 users and is a convenient way our school can keep you up to date with latest news, school updates, newsletters, school operational status and upcoming events which you can add to your personal calendar. You can choose to receive instant notifications when there is an update from the school and access the same content that's on our school website in an accessible way when you are on the go.

The app has advanced privacy and security features, and it won't store any identifying data. It is free and available for iOS and Android users so you can download the NSW Education Parent App in the [Apple Store](#) or [Google Play](#). Once you download the app, you will need to complete the onboarding process in the Parent App to select the school(s) you'd like to follow and enable your push notifications in your phone's settings and in the app's School Settings to make sure you never miss an important update. On Wednesday afternoon, members of the executive team attended the Curiosity and Powerful Learning conference where Leanne Nixon, Deputy Secretary School Performance (North), addressed executive from schools across the state. Mrs Fletcher and Mrs Buyruk presented to colleagues during the conference on Caddies Creek's journey on the use of explicit teaching processes throughout the school to improve student learning. I would like to acknowledge the hard work of our Assistant Principals and Deputy Principals in supporting student and staff learning at the school.

Our Kindy Orientation processes will conclude on Monday with our final day of classroom visits. If you know of anyone who has not enrolled their kindy child for school next year, please ask them to contact the school as soon as possible.

Next week we will begin the complex process of organising class structures for 2023. The staff spend many hours looking at structures and student needs when creating classes. To ensure that the needs of students are met, I have asked for parents to forward information that you believe should be considered regarding the formation of classes for next year. Requests can include information regarding medical conditions, requests to have particular children separated and / or any other aspect that you feel may have an impact on your child's learning. Parents are asked to forward requests to myself, via email or in writing by Monday 21st November to ensure your child's needs can be considered.

Classes who won the P&C Movie reward afternoon enjoyed this treat this week. Thank you to our P&C's continued support of the school. Classes are enjoying the 90 new iPads that have been purchased this year.

With Christmas fast approaching, we understand that small items such as candy canes and Christmas chocolates are often shared on student cards. 


