Our school receives 20% cash commission, resulting in **\$4062** for our school. Best of all, our students are furthering their love of reading and books! We also received 34 book donations to add to our Library collection. Well done team Caddies!

A big thank you to our very hard working, dedicated and generous **P & C volunteers** who assisted with the running of this 3-day event. Without their help, the Book Fair of this size, would not have run as smoothly and successfully as it did.
