### **News from the Deputy Principal**

#### **EAL/D Education at Caddies Creek**

Last week our members of our specialist support met with representatives of our parent community to discuss our work centred on EAL/D education at Caddies Creek PS. Over the course of this year, I have shared information about our work on enhancing our support of students who have English as an Additional Dialect or Language (EAL/D). Our teachers have worked consistently over the course of the year to look at the EAL/D Progression phases, report these phases to parents and further develop effective teaching and learning strategies. Having a chance to chat with parents about their understanding of this work and their children as EAL/D learners was highly valuable for our team. We heard that we need to continue our communication with parents around how EAL/D learners are identified and how this relates to their growth and attainment at school. We also learnt that we should continue our communication regarding the phases and what this means, especially close to our next reporting period. As a result of our conversation, we are also preparing an information session for parents regarding EAL/D processes and aspects of teaching and learning. Thank you to our parents that were able to be involved with this focus group. We value our parent / school partnerships and the chance to have such an important conversation with our community.

#### **Check-in Assessments**

Year 6 – Term 3, Week 9 (12 – 15 September) Years 3 – 5 - Term 4, Weeks 1-4 (10 October – 4 November)

At Caddies Creek PS we value assessment data as valuable information to guide our teaching and learning programs and to ensure we are being responsive to student needs and current knowledge and skills.

Check-in assessments are online assessment for students in Years 3 to 9. They are mapped to the NSW Syllabuses and National Literacy and Numeracy Learning Progressions.

Year 3 - 5 students sit two assessments, one for reading and one for numeracy Year 6 sit three assessments – reading and numeracy and this year for the first time an online writing assessment will be completed.

Each assessment lasts about 60 minutes and consists of between 40 to 50 multiple choice questions for reading and numeracy for Years 3-6 and an online writing assessment for Year 6.

The data generated from this assessment is for school use to guide teaching and learning. Parent feedback is not provided for this assessment.

#### **Parent Teacher Interviews**

Parent/teacher interviews are being held in Week 9, 12 - 15 September for our mainstream classes as we have recently completed review meetings with parents from Support Unit classes.

These Parent/Teacher interviews are optional and are for parents and teachers to discuss the progress of students and any additional supports that are in place to promote growth and attainment. To book an interview please follow the steps below.

#### RE: School Run4 Fun Colour Explosion - Parent Consent

Thank you to date for your support with the P&C Run4Fun Colour Explosion. The event is less than a week away which is very exciting. The event will be held between 11am – 3pm on Thursday 8<sup>th</sup> September 2022 on the school oval.

It is our responsibility to seek permission for your child to participate in the School Run4Fun Colour Explosion. All measures have been taken to ensure that this event is safe for all students.

There will be various colour powder stations throughout the course. Your child can still participate in the event should you not wish for them to be sprayed with colour powder (they will be asked to approach the powder stations with crossed arms if they don't want to be puffed with powder) but it should be noted that we can't guarantee that they won't get some powder on them especially if it is a windy day.

The P&C volunteers will do their best to throw the powder at the torso, however wind and other factors can cause the powder to protrude on the face. Children will be provided with a pair of sunglasses for the event or children can bring in their own goggles to wear if you'd prefer.

The colour powder used in the event is non-toxic, biodegradable and environmentally friendly consisting of 98% corn starch and 2% food colouring. It will likely washout of your child's clothing, however we recommend that your child wears a plain white shirt that you don't mind being coloured. That's what the event is all about!

Based on the toxicology profiles of the powders used, their concentrations in the formulation and the mode of use, the colour powder is considered safe for use. Students with lung issues such as asthma are advised to be careful in their decision to participate.
